FAMILY FUN STARTS IN ONTARIO

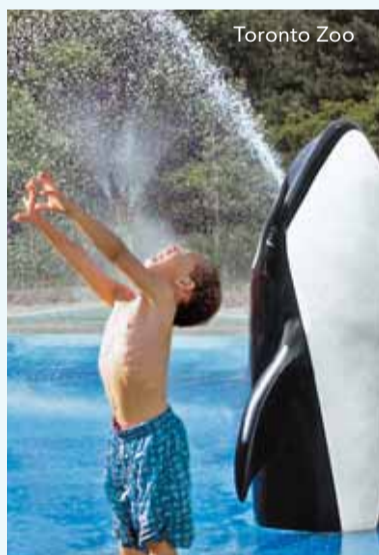
Toronto
